### NOMINATION

You must be nominated to Lakehead University by your home institution or exchange coordinator. You must have your home co-ordinator complete and submit the Nomination Form, and send it to: studyabroad@lakeheadu.ca



After submitting the Nomination Form, please complete and submit the Incoming Exchange Application Form. For Fee-Paying Graduate Exchange Students, please complete and submit the Study Abroad Application Form for Graduate Students. Submit these forms to: studyabroad@lakeheadu.ca

SUBMIT YOUR SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Along with these forms, you must also submit two supporting documents to studyabroad@lakeheadu.ca: an official copy of your academic transcripts: and a letter of attestation from your home institution stating that you are proficient in the English language. For Graduate (Masters) Fee Paying Exchange students, you must also submit proof of degree.
