was established November 1st, 1989, as a result of a long time desire within the Sámi community to have a teacher education with emphasis on the Sámi learning view, forms of teaching and Sámi traditional teaching, which is adapted to the current and future needs. Later the goal expanded to offer other higher-level education in Sámi language in a Sámi-language environment. An independent Sámi teaching institution also gave the Sámi community the opportunity to develop and offer studies that meet the needs of the Sámi community across borders. Most of our studies are in North Sámi language, but we also offer some few courses for students who do not speak the Sámi language. Among others, Master in Sámi Journalism from an Indigenous Perspective.

Mixed courses	Students can choose courses from different departments. However, it is important to check that the course timetables are compatible with one another.

Admission requirements	
Minimum academic requirements	Students must fulfil the prerequisites for each course. These requirements are outlined in the course catalogue.

Language requirements	
Recommended level of proficiency	B2 in English (for courses where instruction language is English).
Proof of language proficiency	In case of exchange students, no official test result is required. The international coordinators at the home institution are responsible for recruiting students with sufficient language skills.

Cost of living and Financial requirements	
Estimated cost of living per semester	An estimation of a student's cost of living is made and revised yearly by the the Norwegian State Educational Loan Fund (Lånekassen) and Norwegian Directorate of Immigration (UDI). Their recommendation is that you need approximately NOK 121 220 for the study year 2019-2020 (10 months).

Residence/Student permit	
EU/EEA/Swiss citizens	Students who are staying more than three months in Norway must register an application online at the UDI (Immigration office) and make an appointment at the local Police station on arrival.
Non-EU citizens	The Norwegian Directorate of Norwegian Immigration (UDI) requires that you apply for a study permit prior to arrival.
